Bid Description

Project Requirements

Contracts over \$25,000 will require a 100% performance bond, a 100% labor and materials bond, and bidder may be required to furnish a bid bond in the amount of 10% of the submitted bid. All projects are subject to the Prevailing Wage Rages, California Labor Code, California Public Contract Code and the Department of Industrial Relations. Contractors who have been prequalified may be required to submit certifications of compliance with the procedures for implementation of the Disabled Veterans Business Enterprise Contracting Goals. Contractors are allowed according to Public Contract Code § 22300 to submit "securities of lieu of retention".

Note that the prequalification process does not constitute an agreement with the District, nor is it an obligation upon the District to enter any agreements.
