## Measure L Update: June

During the month of June 2015, the following Measure L related actions and activities are occurring:

- **Modular Structures.** Education Code 17292 necessitates the removal of various temporary buildings (modulars) on both campuses. Before the programs and services housed in the offline modulars can move into permanent structures (the North County Campus Center and San Luis Obispo Campus Instructional Building will be completed in fall of 2017), they will be housed in new modulars. On June 8, the first four of 17 modulars arrived on the North County Campus in Paso Robles. The remaining modulars will arrive within the coming days and be situated behind the Fox Building (N2400) and in front of the Schwartz Learning Resource Center (N3100 and N3200). The SLO Campus modulars will also be installed during June and reside near the Campus Police office (6600) and cafeteria (5100). All modulars will be occupied by fall 2015.
- **Aquatic Center Repair.** Although the major repair to the San Luis Obispo Campus aquatics facility will take place as scheduled during the winter months of 2015-16, a portion of the repair will take place in June. The deck surrounding both pools on campus will be scanned for pipe leaks; all affected pipes will be immediately repaired. The repairs are not anticipated to affect aquatics courses.
- **Citizens' Oversight Committee (COC).** At the June 3 Board of Trustees meeting, it was reported that the COC had met for a second time on May 14. The members reviewed and discussed the first Measure L Quarterly Financial Report, which summarized bond income and expenditures. The COC will next meet on August 13.
